At The Royal Academy of Dramatic Art, I spent 3 very intense years training with the cream of the cream and being taught by some of the most inspirational innovative teachers within UK and World, drama training. Encouraged to develop first and foremost our 'imaginations' opened my mind to nonlinear, creative forms of training. Based on intuition, instinct, and living as much in the moment as possible, such key ingredients should always support the technical and crafted aspects of any acting training. These ingredients I took with me through my career and allowed me to evolve my acting craft through theatre, Film and extensive television work. Please refer to my IMDB record.

Alongside my theatre and screen career, in my late twenties, I came across Capoeira – a Brazilian Martial Art. This very intense and culturally complex art form not only helped to keep my mind and body fit but also helped to develop my singing voice, musical percussive skills and workshop leadership skills. Such mental, physical and creative disciplines are necessary for any self-employed creative that wants a career for the long term.
